Providing the COVID-19 Vaccine to Vulnerable Communities

RALEIGH, NC – Advance Community Health aims to register hundreds of people for the COVID-19 vaccine every week. We not only serve those in our vulnerable communities, but those who *serve* our vulnerable communities.

This week we continue to partner with Wake County Schools and schedule appointments for nearly 200 employees. Tomorrow we welcome over 200 people for their second shot in our Saturday clinic. We are now adding frontline essential workers to our list. We're working closely with our local HBCU's, Shaw University and St. Augustine's University to get employees vaccinated. We're also working closely with the Mexican Consulate to get their staff and clients vaccinated. We invite all other frontline essential workers (i.e., college staff, public transit, grocery workers, farm workers, restaurant workers, public safety) to get vaccinated in our clinic.

Total vaccines as of 3/04/21: 2,738

1,593 first doses

681 second doses

Of the first dose patients:

49% Black/African American

19% from the 27610 zip code

Of those full vaccinated:

66% Black/African American

31% from the 27610 zip code
